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Nothing Is Everything

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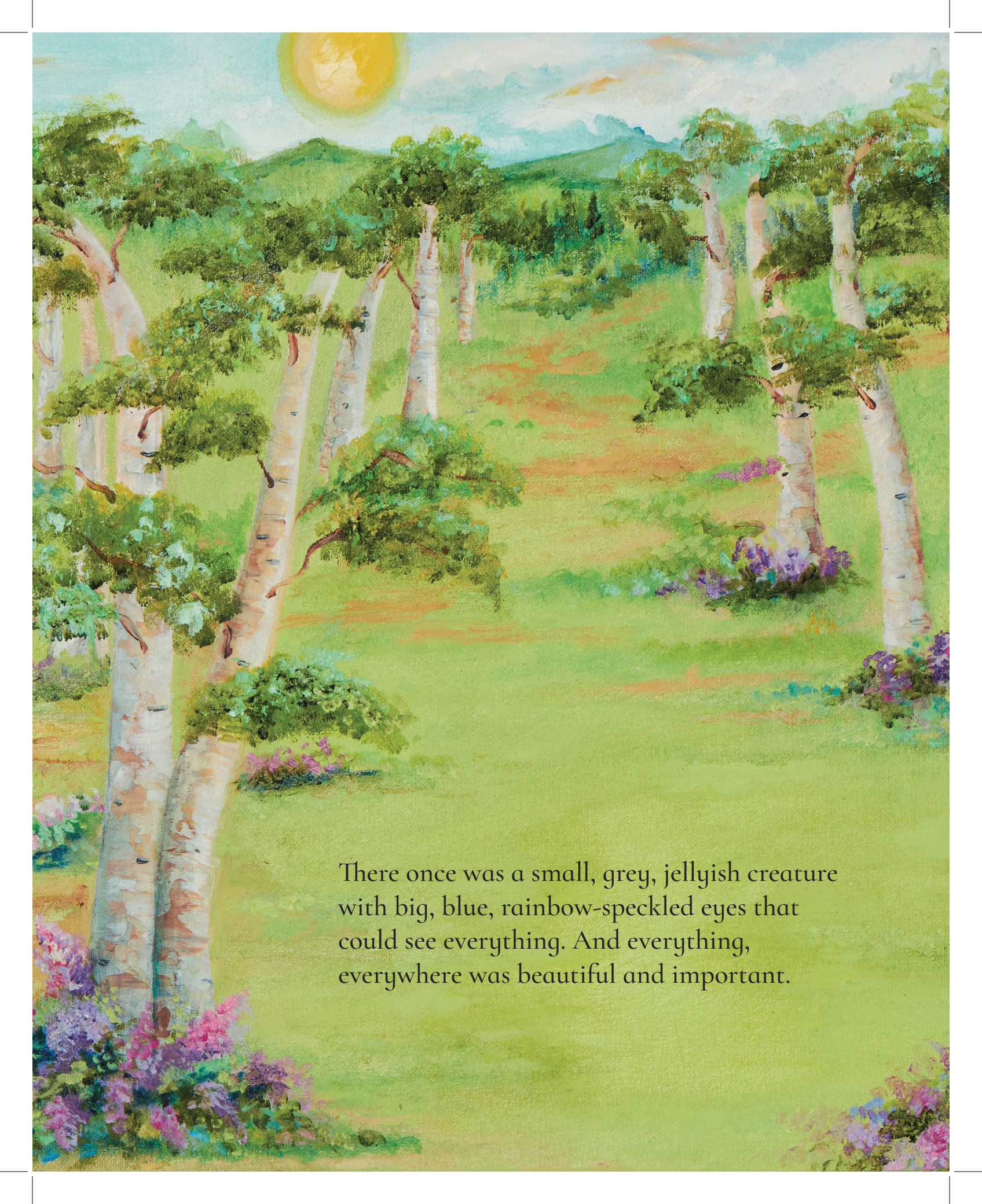
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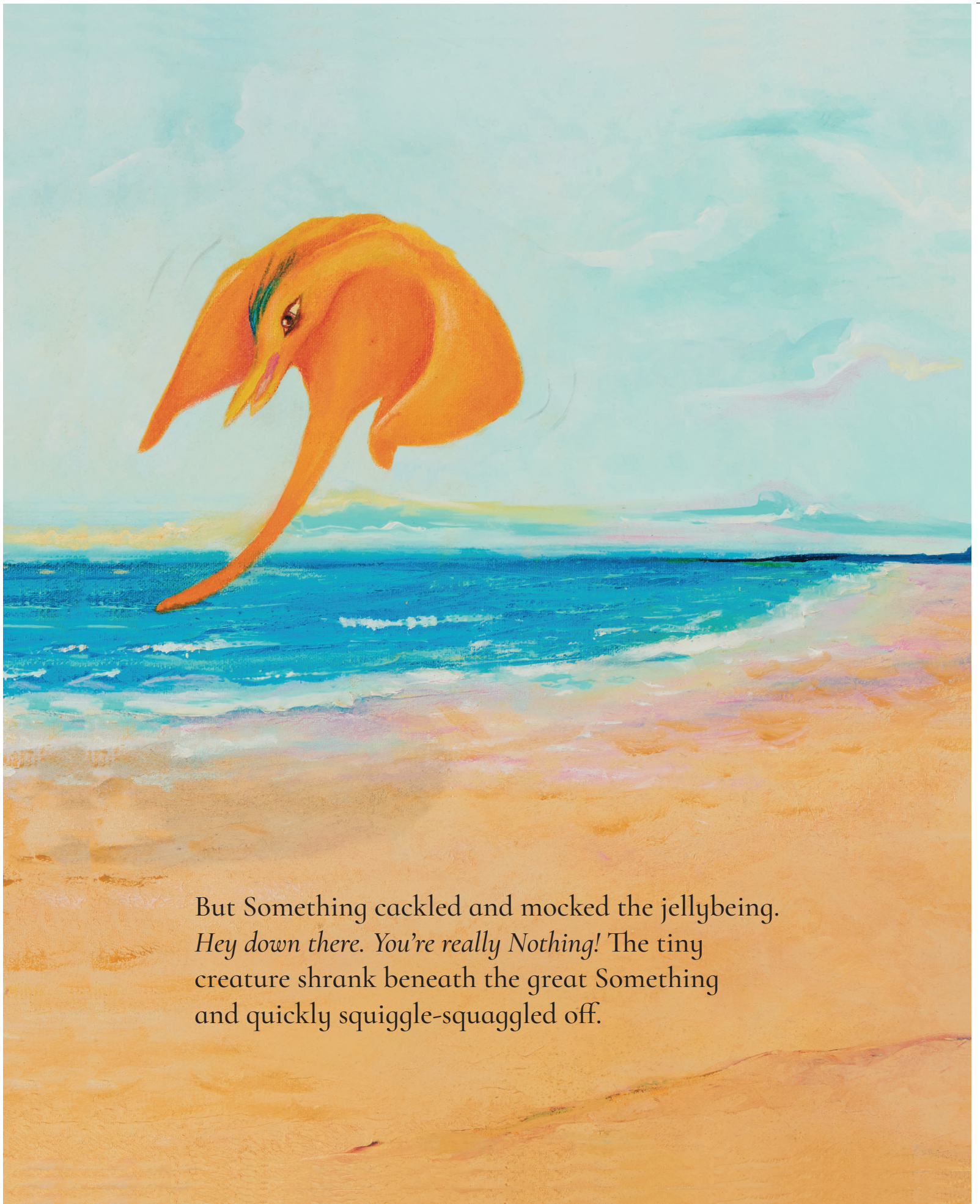
There once was a small, grey, jellyish creature

the creature. *Hey, up there. You're really Something!*

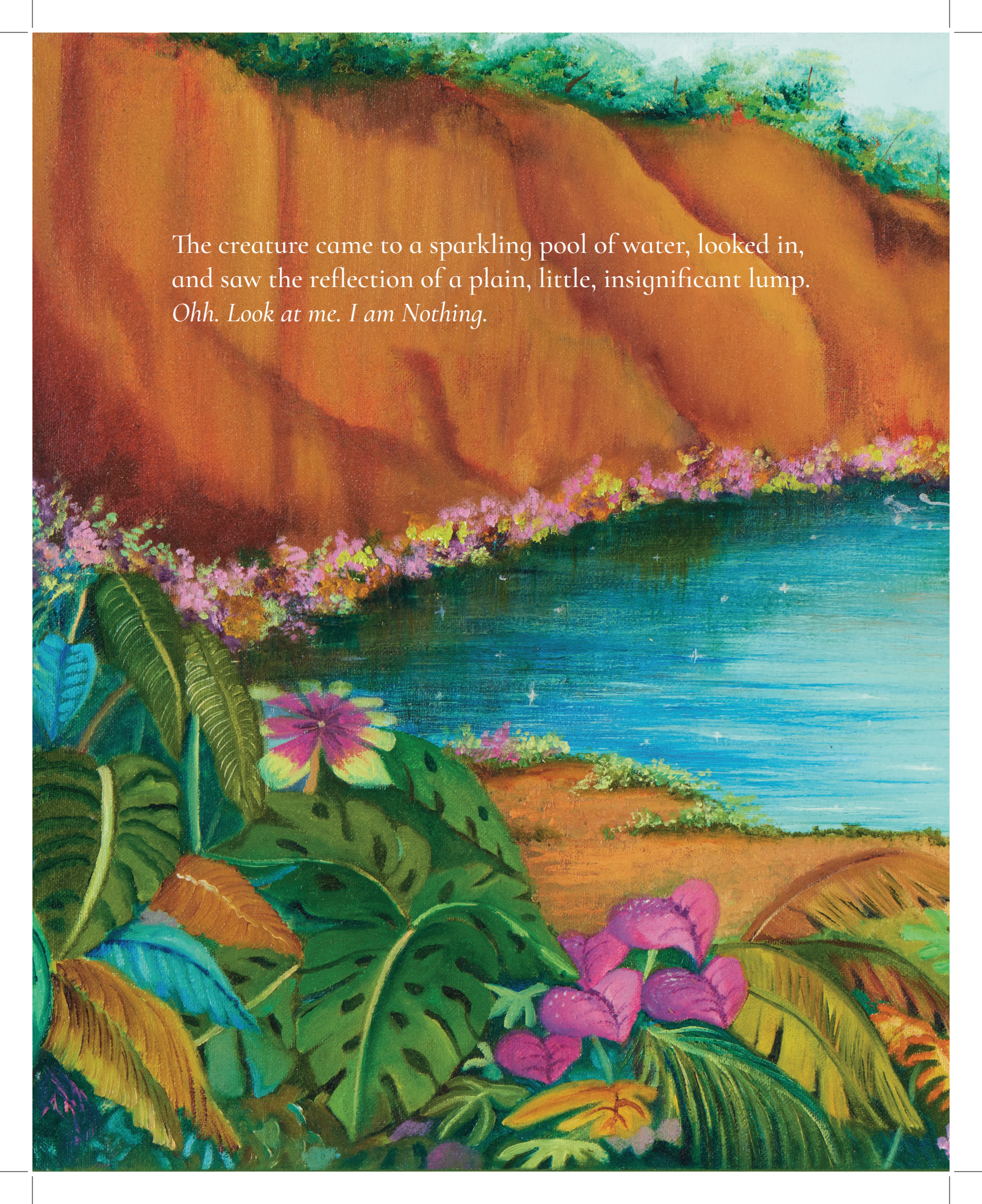








But Something cackled and mocked the jellybeing.
